## CHRIST SANCTUARY INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL REGULATIONS.

- 1. I) Morning Prayers: Shall be said 6:30a.m by all pupils. ii) Evening Prayers: Shall be said by all the pupils before they retire to their beds.
- 2. The general cleanliness outside the school buildings shall be done according to duty teachers' organizations.
- 3. The Pupils shall respond to the signal or the bell immediately and silently.
- 4. I) In order to move from one classroom to another one, a pupil shall obtain permission from his class prefect.
  ii) During the time of doing tests or examinations pupils shall not make unnecessary movements or noise. iii) A pupil who involves himself in examinations malpractice will be severely punished.
- 5. The Prefects and House Captains shall exercise strict discipline onto the pupils in the classrooms, dormitories, dining-hall, Church and Assemblies.
- 6. Pupils shall not play in any form at all in any of the rooms and neither at any of the building verandah.
- 7. Pupils shall keep clean in proper school uniform, with clean bodies, with short nails, short hair, well-combed at all times.
- Pupils shall not bring any other clothes for wearing (Sweater & Jackets inclusive) at school apart from the school uniform. The forbidden clothes will be confiscated.
- 9. Pupils shall not wear slippers at official school functions and when going out for school activities.
- 10. Pupils shall speak English.
- 11. I) A visiting parent shall seek permission from a duty teacher in order to talk and see his son after presenting a visitation card.ii) Such a parent will sign a Visitors' Book.
- 12. Pupils shall not ride a bicycle nor drive a motor vehicle at the school premises.
- 13. A duty teacher shall control the in-coming and out-going letters of the pupils.
- 14. A pupil who escapes from the school premises shall be automatically Expelt from the school.
- 15. All healthy pupils shall participate in the school games and sports and any other extra curriculum activities.
- 16. When a parent comes to check on his/her sons' academic performance, he/she shall not bring any eats or money for him/them.

- 17. Any pupil found in possession of money, Radio or toys will be punished and will all lose such material as will have been found. If repeated, he could face suspension and possible expulsion.
- 18. Any pupil who practices acts of violence/terror to others will not be tolerated. I.e. teasing.
- 19. At the end of each academic year promotions are made depending on the percentage score, P.1 to P.6 is 60%. Those who fail to reach that limit can be advised accordingly.
- 20. Any adult who on behalf of a pupil will be found to have given false information to the school; about age, religion or past results etc. could face possible court action.
- 21. Any pupil who causes damage to school property and is found guilty, shall be punished and fined accordingly.

**N.B.** It's important to understand that there are many more rules not necessarily written here, therefore it is better to consult before doing anything.
